

<u>Y3 Thinking like a Theologist</u> <u>Christianity : Jesus' Miracles</u>

<u>Key Knowledge:</u>

Christians believe Jesus is God in a human body so has the power of God and can do anything, including healing people.

Christians believe Jesus is the incarnation of God and that he had a special ability to heal people.

As part of his ministry (described in the New Testament), Jesus performed many miracles.

The Blind Man Jesus and his disciples saw a man who had been blind since birth. Jesus spit on the ground, made some mud with the saliva and put it on the man's eyes. He told him to

wash the mud off and when he did, the man could see.

The Paralysed Man Jesus was preaching the word of God to a large crowd of people. Some men came, bringing a paralysed man with them but they could not get him to Jesus. They made an opening in the roof and lowered the man into the room. Jesus told the paralysed man his sins were forgiven. He told the man to get up and go home. The paralysed man got up and walked home.
