

PiXL Apps: Pupil Login and User Instructions

PiXL Mental Maths / Times Tables App

Overview

The PiXL Apps are designed to help pupils build fluency, recall, and confidence through short, interactive quizzes. The PiXL Times Table App supports number fluency and rapid recall of multiplication facts, while the PiXL Vocabulary App strengthens subject-specific vocabulary across the curriculum.

Login & Setup

1. Visit <https://timestable.pixl.org.uk/> and click on 'Click here to launch the app'
2. Enter your school code – JR8016.
3. Enter your username and password (given by school).
4. Select your year group or times table set and begin practising.
5. If you forget your login details, please ask your class teacher to reset them.

How to Use the App

- Choose 'Practice' mode to focus on one times table or skill at a time.
- Choose 'Time Attack' to beat your personal best.
- Choose 'Check' or 'Mixed' to revise across different tables or skills.
- Teachers can assign home tasks and track your scores.

Tips for Success

- Use the app little and often (5–10 minutes each day).
- Compete with friends or your previous scores to stay motivated.
- Focus on accuracy first, then speed.
- Check your leaderboard to track progress.

PiXL Vocabulary App – 'Unlock'

Login & Setup

1. Visit <https://vocab.pixl.org.uk/> and click on 'Click here to launch the app'
2. Enter your school code <https://vocab.pixl.org.uk/>, username, and password (provided by school).
3. If you have login problems, ask your teacher to confirm your setup.

How to Use the App

- Play games and complete activities to learn new words.

- Select your topic area (e.g. KS1 general vocabulary or subject vocabulary).
- Earn points as you progress through each challenge.
- Teachers can view how often you practise and your progress.

Tips for Success

- Use the app both at home and at school to build strong vocabulary.
- Aim for 5 minutes of daily practice.
- Parents can help by asking you to explain and use new words in sentences.
- Celebrate your progress with your class or at home.

3. Parent and Carer Guidance

- Help your child log in for the first time and record their details somewhere safe.
- Encourage regular short practice sessions rather than long ones.
- Ask your child what they learned or achieved each time they use the app.
- Contact the class teacher if login issues occur or progress isn't showing.
- Make sure the app is updated to the latest version for best performance.
