My new class will be Fir Class. This booklet will tell me all about being in Fir Class with Mrs Adams.

When I come to school...

I will come in through the gate and this door.

I will come to school between 8:35am and 8:50am. My grown up will not be able to stay with me. They will walk me to my classroom door and then drop me off and leave. There will be adults from school there to help me.



I will keep my things here...in the corridor outside Fir class.

I will take as little as possible to and from school each day. I will only bring a water bottle, my reading books when I get them. I can leave some spare clothes, waterproofs in school in the tray under my peg.

This is my new classroom...

Fir classroom might be set out a little bit differently to your old one. What do you think makes our new classroom special?





I will use these toilets...

When I go to the toilet, I will need to ask a grown up first. I would usually go to the toilet during Discovery Time and not during my adult-led learning.



During Discovery Time, I can choose between inside or outside.

I will use these areas outside and my classroom area. If I have any problems, I can go to any of the adults. If I hurt myself, there will be a first aider who can help me.



At lunchtime...

I will eat my lunch in the Infant Hall. My lunchtime is at 12pm.

For lunch, I can eat a school dinner or bring a packed lunch in from home (it must be nut free). I need to wash my hands carefully before I eat. I will use a tray to collect my school dinner and be responsible for clearing away my plate when I have finished. There will be adults I know to help me.



At lunchtimes...

I can join lunchtime play at the Infant School after I have eaten my lunch until 1.15pm. I may use the Infant playground and eventually Infant Adventure. If I have a sibling, they can come to see me but I must stay in the Infant zones.



Assemblies...

Some of our assemblies will take place in the hall in the mornings. Others will take place in the classroom. Our teacher will let us know which we have.

When I go home, I will leave through Fir Class door. My grown up will wait on the patio outside Fir class door. I will wait until my name is called. Once my name is called by the school adult I can go.



The gates will open at 3.05 p.m. and my adult will collect me at 3:10 p.m.

We will need to leave the school grounds straight away not stay and play.

When I come to school, I will wear school uniform...



It is important that I am able to dress and undress myself. This includes being able to do up my own shoes for both the school day and PE lessons. I will also be asked to keep wellington boots, waterproof trousers, coat and spare clothes in school.

FS2 Helpful Tips...

READING

Children will change their reading books every week. They may also independently select a book from the classroom 'little library'.

Children should read for 10 minutes each night at home with you and you can record this in their reading record. We encourage each book to be read multiple times to help with fluency and word recognition.

SPARE CLOTHES

Please send in a named bag with a spare set of clothes and underwear. We need them in case of toilet accidents or wet outdoor play. Children will keep these in a small bag on their peg or in their drawer.

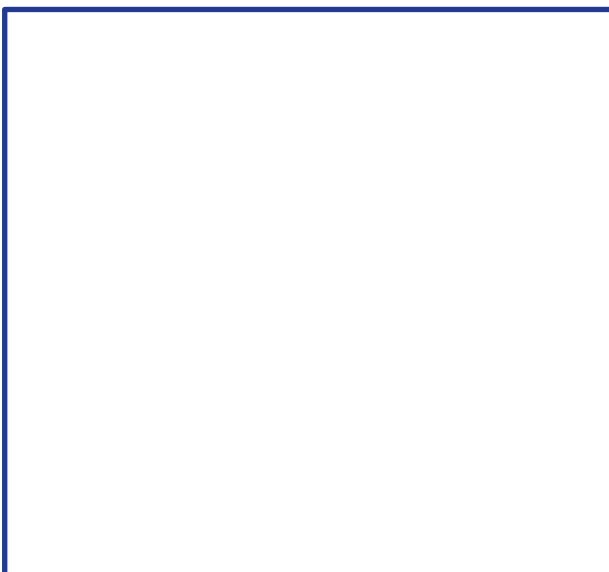
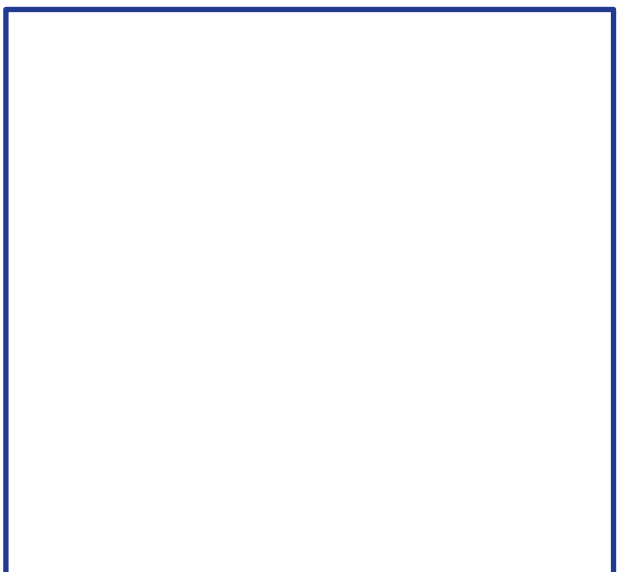
Please send in a pair of wellies that can stay in school.

All the adults are very excited to welcome you to school!

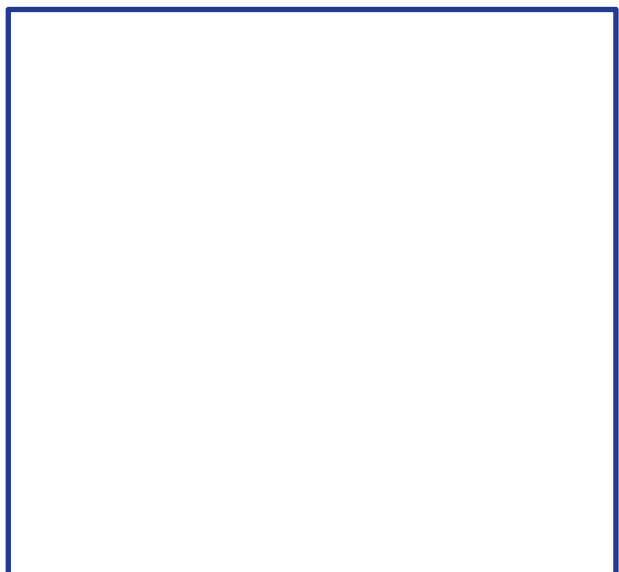
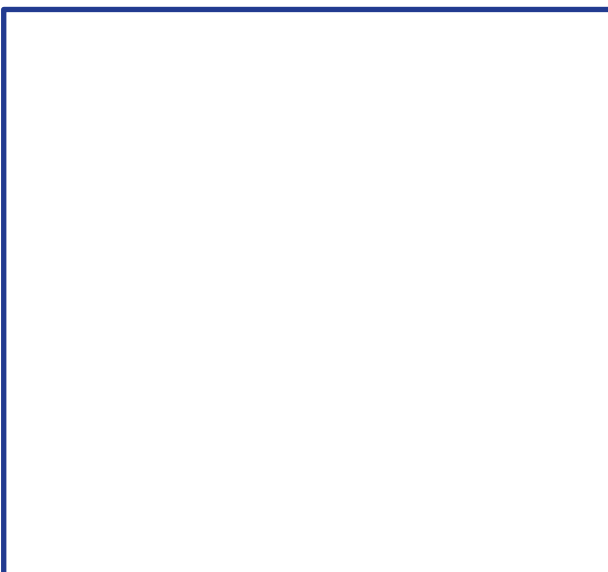
We will have so much fun together in Fir class.
