When I go to the toilet, I will need to ask a grown up first. It is important that I try to go to the toilet during playtimes.





At playtimes...

We will use this area. If I have any problems at playtime, I can go to any of the adults who are outside. If I hurt myself, there will be a first aider who can help me. My playtime is at 10:30.



At lunchtime...

I will eat my lunch either in the hall or outside, if the weather is nice. My lunchtime is at 12:15. For lunch, I can eat a school dinner or bring a packed lunch in from home. I need to wash my hands carefully before I eat.

Our assemblies will take place in the hall every morning.

My adult will collect me at 3:15 and we will need to leave the school grounds following the one way system.

When I come to school, I will wear school uniform...



I will need a waterproof coat in school. I may bring a change of footwear for break and lunch times and a change of clothes can be kept in a bag on my peg for changing after OPAL play if needed.

The only jewellery to be worn is a watch. No bracelets, ankle bracelets, rings etc. are allowed. Earrings should be studs which will have to be removed or taped over for P.E.

I will get changed for P.E. in school and changed back into my uniform after P.E.

Year Four Helpful Tips...

READING

Children will independently change their reading books, every day if they need to. When they have finished their reading book, either at school or at home, they will return it and choose a new one that they like the look of.

Children should read for 10 minutes each night at home with you and you should leave a comment about how they got on in their reading record.

SPARE CLOTHES

Please ensure your child has a pair of wellies and wet weather gear that can stay in school for wet conditions.

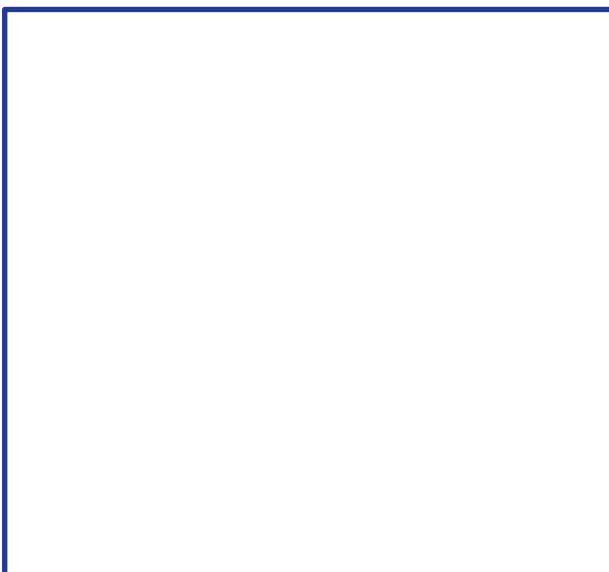
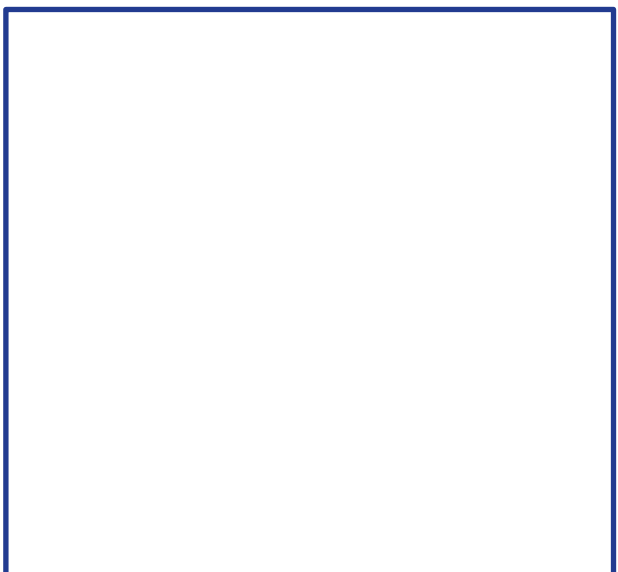
ADDITIONAL NOTES

All the adults are very excited to welcome us all back to school!

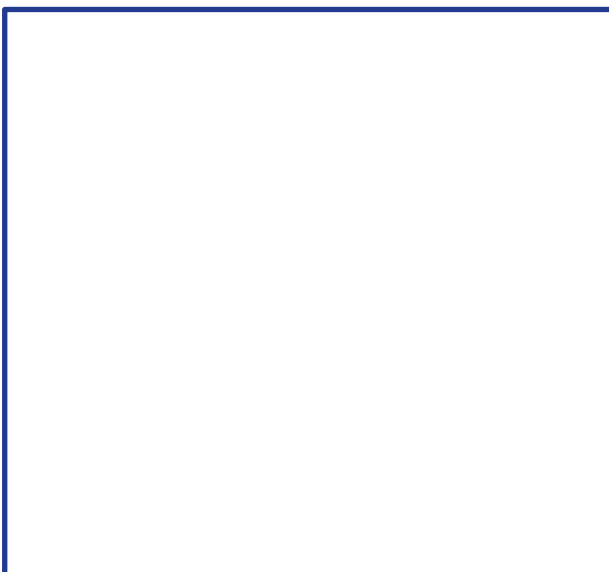
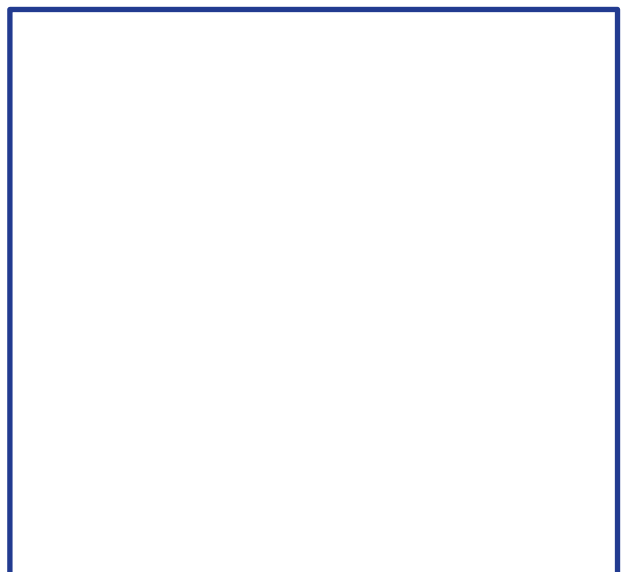
We will have so much fun together in Chestnut class.
