I will eat my lunch either in the hall or outside, depending on the weather. For lunch, I can eat a school dinner or bring a packed lunch in from home.

I will need a waterproof coat in school. I may bring a change of footwear for break and lunch times and a change of clothes can be kept in a bag on my peg for changing after OPAL play if needed.

The only jewellery permitted is a watch. No bracelets, ankle bracelets, rings etc. are allowed. Earrings should be studs which will have to be removed or taped over for P.E.

Year Five Helpful Tips...

READING

Children will independently change their reading books, every day if they need to. When they have finished their reading book, either at school or at home, they will return it and choose a new one.

Children should read for 10 minutes each night at home with you and you should leave a comment about how they got on in their reading record.

HOMEWORK

Homework is sent home on Fridays and must be returned to school on Wednesdays. Homework will include reading, a debate question and a maths activity.

SPARE CLOTHES

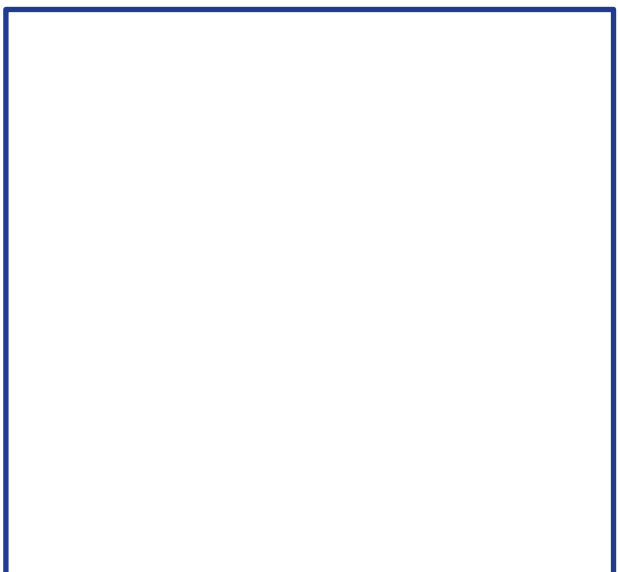
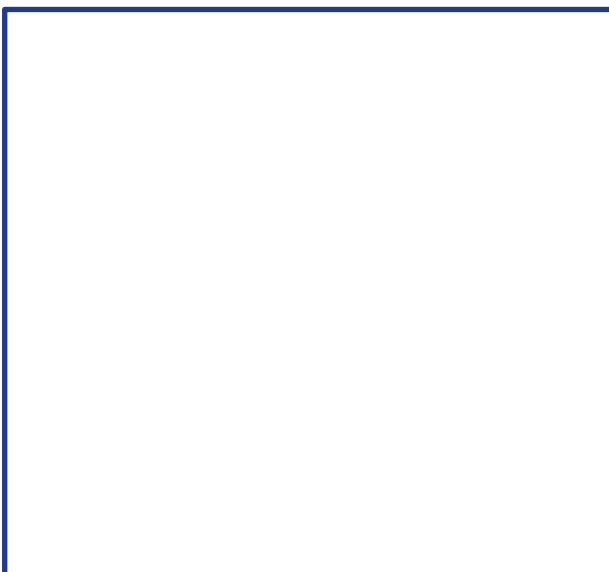
Please ensure your child has a pair of wellies and wet weather gear that can stay in school for wet conditions.

Please ensure your child does not bring their own equipment to school as this will be provided.

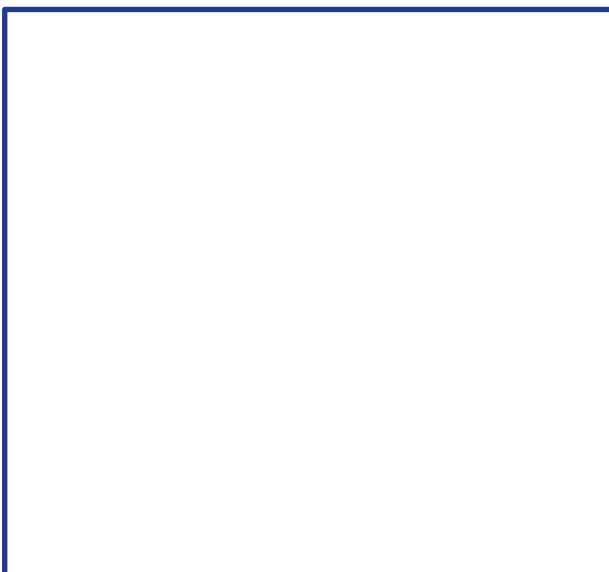
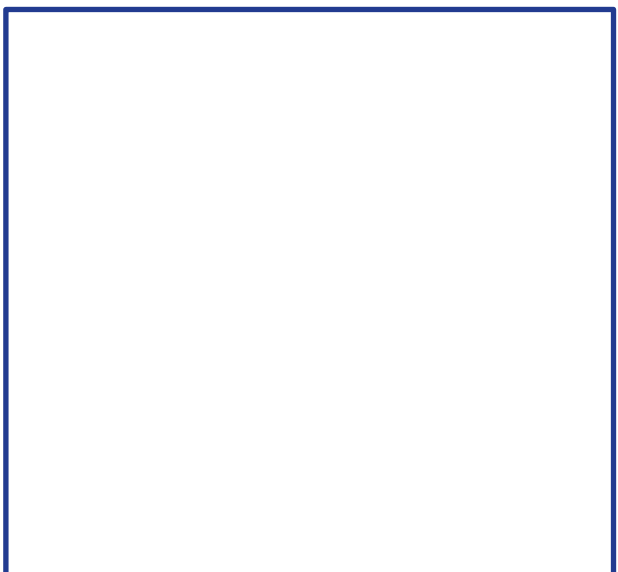
We do not allow any fiddle toys or other toys to come into school. Parents are responsible for ensuring these are left at home. If your child requires a concentration aid, we will provide one in school.
